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Admission Policy

FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26
Department of Business Studies
Centre for Distance and Online Education

This policy shall be called the 'ADMISSION POLICY 2025-26' (AP - 2025-26) for admission to the degree programmes offered by The Department of Business Studies, Centre for Distance and Online Education, THE NORTHCAP UNIVERSITY, GURUGRAM, at the Undergraduate Levels.

This Admission Policy 2025-26 is approved by the Board of Management of The NorthCap University, Gurugram. All admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with merit in a fair and transparent manner on the basis of minimum eligibility / selection criteria as prescribed for each programme.

1. APPLICABILITY

- 1.1 This "Admission Policy - 2025-26" is valid for the academic year 2025-26 and shall be applicable for admissions of all resident Indian students to UG programmes of Department of Business Studies, Centre for Distance and Online Education.
- 1.2 The University has a comprehensive and transparent policy regarding Fee Structure, refund, cancellation & withdrawal. The Refund & Cancellation policy is in line with UGC-DEB policy.
- 1.3 Admissions are taken twice in each year i.e. for July-Dec session and Jan-June session.

2. PROGRAMMES OFFERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS STUDIES, CENTRE FOR DISTANCE AND ONLINE EDUCATION -THEIR INTAKE AND MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR THE YEAR 2025-26

2.1 Eligibility Criteria for Undergraduate programmes at The Department of Business Studies

S.No	PROGRAMME	MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA
1.	BBA	10+2 examination conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education or equivalent examination from a recognised board with an overall aggregate 40%.
2.	B.COM	10+2 examination conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education or equivalent examination from a recognised board with an overall aggregate 40%.

- I. Rounding of marks in the aggregate and /or in the compulsory subject (s), wherever applicable is not permitted.
- II. The eligibility criteria shown in the table above is subject to change by the university.
- III. An applicant from a university/board not recognised by CBSE/AICTE/UGC/AIU/MoE or any other statutory body of Government of India shall not be eligible for admission.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 3.1 In the event that the Admission Committee of the University is not satisfied with the character or antecedents of an applicant, in the overall interest of maintaining the academic standards and discipline of the University, it retains the exclusive right not to admit him/her to the University.
- 3.2 A student who furnishes particulars or submits documents which are found to be false, or suppresses material information, shall not be considered for admission, and, if he/ she has been admitted on the basis of such information, besides legal action at his/ her cost, his/ her admission shall stand automatically cancelled and the entire fee of any description whatsoever paid by him/ her shall stand fully forfeited.
- 3.3 Mere possession of the prescribed academic qualifications does not entitle a candidate for admission. Candidates shall have to fulfill all other conditions as have been spelt out in this "Admission Policy - 2025-26" and on the website for the programme/category in which admission is sought.

4. ADMISSION COMMITTEE

- 4.1 Admissions shall be made by the Admission Committee comprising of faculty and administrative staff of the Department/University to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.

- 4.2 The Committee shall scrutinize the application forms for admission of the candidates in accordance with the eligibility/selection criteria prescribed in this 'Admission Policy 2025-26'.
- 4.3 The decision of the Admission Committee on any matter concerning the Admission Policy shall be final and binding on all concerned, subject to review as per Clause 11 (Grievances and Redressal Mechanism) of this AP 2025-26.

5. ADMISSION NOTICE

- 5.1 To fill the seats for UG programmes offered for the Academic Session 2025-26, the University shall publish an admission notice inviting applications from interested candidates on the official website: www.ncuonline.edu.in
- 5.2 A copy of the admission notice along with this 'Admission Policy 2025-26' shall be uploaded on the main website of the University www.ncuindia.edu and on The University online Website www.ncuonline.edu.in for the information of all concerned.

6. HOW TO APPLY

- 6.1 A candidate can participate in the admission process only through filling of an online application form: Candidates can fill in the form online on the university online programme website www.ncuonline.edu.in and upload self-attested scanned copies of documents mentioned in Clause 6.2 along with the online application. They will receive an email confirmation for their online application submitted.

7. ADMISSION POLICY AND SECURING YOUR ADMISSION

The Admission Policy 2025-26 for admission to BBA and B.Com. Online programmes in Department of Business Studies, CDOE shall be available in soft copy form on the University online Programme website: www.ncuonline.edu.in All candidates are advised to thoroughly read the entire Admission Policy 2025-26 before applying for admission.

- 7.1 Applicants should submit only one application form for the selected programme.
- 7.2 It is made clear that admissions shall be made strictly based on eligibility, to those who have applied on the prescribed form, within the stipulated time limit prescribed in this Admission Policy 2025-26 or as may be amended and uploaded on the website and whose application has not been invalidated due to any deficiency. Applications which are incomplete and not in the prescribed form and not accompanied with the self-attested copies of documents as given in Clause 6.2 of AP 2025-26 shall be rejected.
- 7.3 In the event, an applicant fails to deposit his/her fee on or before the date specified in Clause 9.1, the offer of admission will stand automatically withdrawn and the applicant will have no claim whatsoever on the seat.

8. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF APPLICATION FORMS

- 8.1 Applicants must insist on a receipt for the application form if submitted at the campus physically.
- 8.2 Online applications shall be acknowledged by e-mail confirmation.
- 8.3 The receipt/acknowledgement shall constitute the only evidence for timely submission of the application form.

14. REFUND, CANCELLATION & WITHDRAWAL POLICY

14.1 The University has a comprehensive and transparent policy regarding Fee Structure, refund, cancellation & withdrawal. The Refund & Cancellation policy is in line with UGC-DEB policy.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Tuition Fees	Point of Time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received by the University
1	100%	Before last date of admission as specified by UGC-DEB
2	NIL	After lapse of last date of refund, as specified by UGC-DEB

14.2 The fee for refund implies the amount applicable for the first Semester. Further the applicable fee shall be the amount indicated in this policy against the program.

14.3 If for any reason whatsoever, including insufficient students the University is unable to run any programme, 100% of Tuition fees and all other charges collected at the time of Admission shall be refunded. In such cases, application fees if any, will also be refunded.

14.4 The refund shall be made in the name of the student by crossed account payee cheque only and shall be mailed by Registered post to the student within fifteen days from the date of receiving application. There is no need for the student and /or his/her parent to visit the University in this regard.

14.5 In case a student does not have a bank account and wishes to have his/her refund cheque in the name of either parent, he/she shall submit a notarized affidavit along with the application for withdrawal (specimen of affidavit available at Form-5)

14.6 How to apply for refund of fees?

Mail for Admission Cancellation/refund shall be sent at admissions-cdoe@ncuindia.edu with complete details of admission including application number, fee receipt and the reason of refund, before lapse of last date of admission as specified in the refund/cancellation Policy of the university.

15. LIMITED LIABILITY

All admissions made by the Admission Committee are provisional and subject to confirmation by the Chancellor of the University. If the admission of any candidate is not confirmed by the Chancellor, for any reason whatsoever, the liability of the University will be limited only to the refund of full fee paid by the candidate and that there shall be no further consequent liability on the University and / or any of its employee.

16. MID COURSE WITHDRAWALS

In the event of a mid-course withdrawal i.e., withdrawals after the last date of admission for vacant and drop out seats, no refund of fee shall be admissible, as the seat so vacated cannot be filled by the University and shall continue to remain vacant for the entire duration of the programme. Being an unaided, self-financed University, in addition to the fees of ongoing semester, the University is entitled to claim the balance years' fee, in view of the Constitution Bench Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case titled, "Islamic Academy of Education Vs State of Karnataka" bearing CWP no. 350 of 1993 and related subsequent judgements.

17. JURISDICTION

Disputes, if any, arising out of this University Admission Policy shall be the subject matter exclusively of courts in Gurugram only.
